GEM LEVEL 2 TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

____ Attend Gemstone Therapy 210 and 220 workshops, where you will learn the eight protocols and receive mentor support, or complete the online equivalents listed below.

____ Demonstrate proficiency in the following nine Gemstone Therapy protocols:

1. Advanced Energy Clearing at Levels of Manifestation (GEM 222)
2. Spectrum Balancing Chakras (GEM 223)
3. Chakra Evaluation, Assessment, and Correction with Gemstone Therapy (GEM 224)
4. Gemstone Therapy for Your Relationships (GEM 225)
5. Gemstone Therapy for Partners (GEM 226)
6. Target Area Protocol (GEM 227)
7. Condition Placement Protocol (GEM 228)
8. Belief Renewal Protocol (GEM 229)
9. Systems of the Body Protocol (GEM 230)

____ Gain proficiency in these protocols by performing 100 sessions, 10 of each protocol and an additional 10 of any protocol. You may do more than 100 sessions if you feel you need extra practice to gain proficiency in one or more of them.



- Students may count sessions given during their 200-level workshops and when they serve as an intern at a retreat.
- Students may count sessions in which they serve as secondary practitioner with another Gemstone Therapy Practitioner or Level 2 student.
- Sessions must be performed for at least 25 different clients, 10 of whom may be animals.
- List your 100 sessions on the summary sheet provided in your course packet and submit a copy to your mentor when completed.
- GTI-certified Diamond Therapy Practitioners need only perform 10 each of the eight protocols, for a total of 80 sessions.

____ Submit typed summaries of 25 of your most significant sessions to your mentor for review using the session notes form (included in your course packet) as a basis. Include photos or sketches of custom gemmandalas used. Session write-ups allow us to learn from each other and build a collection of experiences and testimonials. For privacy, do not mention your client's name in these write-ups; use initials. We may publish these on our website student portal.

____ Serve as an intern at a Gemstone Therapy retreat (after you've completed Gemstone Therapy 210/211 and 220/221) and assist practitioners in sessions (these sessions count toward your 100 total). This is an opportunity to practice and debrief sessions with several practitioners and observe each one's unique style and approach to the work.

OR ____ If no retreat is available, serve as secondary practitioner to three different certified Gemstone Therapy Practitioners. List with whom you worked and when, and write a few paragraphs describing what similarities and differences you noticed among their treatment styles.

___ Service. This is an opportunity to learn the work from a different perspective. Choose one of the following:

- Serve as a teaching assistant for a GTI workshop, helping the instructor per TA guidelines.
- Give a talk or PowerPoint presentation about Gemstone Therapy to a group at an expo, wholistic chamber of commerce, or other location.
- Support the Gemstone Therapy Institute with a project that helps promote the work, based on your talents and expertise.

___ Design a self-therapy program for yourself based on your personal health concerns. See program details in your course packet for requirements.

___ Participate in the Level 1 and 2 student coaching calls in order to support and be supported by the Gemstone Therapy community.

___ Become familiar with internal physical anatomy using a good textbook abundant with illustrations. Knowing what the anatomy of each major system looks like is important because its supraphysical counterpart appears nearly identical. In particular, commit to memory the general appearance of blood vessels and capillaries, lymph vessels, and nerves.

___ Attend your mentoring sessions. Please come with questions, session anecdotes and summaries, and personal experiences with the gemstones that you'd like to discuss. Your mentor can answer questions, help you design your self-therapy program (see above requirement), debrief a challenging session, or review answers to the quizzes that come with each of the nine modules.

___ Be able to identify the 50 gemstones listed below and describe one or two benefits or characteristics of each. The better you



understand the indications for these gemstones, the more accurate your gemandala interpretations can be.

____ When you've completed the above requirements, gather them into a single packet and email or mail to your mentor (per your mentor's preference) this completed Level 2 packet, including your 25 type-written session summaries, the summary sheet of the 100 Gemstone Therapy practice sessions, and your self-therapy project.

____ Receive a passing evaluation on the final in-person practical exam.

- Your final examination will be in person. It will last about three hours. During this time, you will be asked questions on any of the material covered in the Level 1 and 2 training.
- In addition, you will also be asked to perform a Gemstone Therapy session on your exam proctor.
- Payment of \$350 includes the exam, follow-up debriefing, and a diploma if you pass.
